Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process that makes it

possible for adults to be received into the Catholic Church. UNDERSTANDING THE RCIA *a journey for the entire parish.* The Rite of Acceptance



The RCIA group have been meeting every week since the beginning of August and are soon to celebrate the first of the RCIA Liturgical Rites. Over the next few weeks we will look at what these Rites involve and how we as a Parish family can further support our Enquirers.

The Rite of Acceptance is the first rite in the RCIA process. It takes place within the context of a Sunday Mass. Those wishing to enter into the second phase of the RCIA (the catechumenate or study phase) make a public commitment to accept the way of the cross. The worshipping community, the members of our parish family, publicly welcome these individuals and promise to support them in their ongoing journey of faith. The **unbaptised** enquirers are now called **catechumens** and are signed with the sign of the cross to remind them of their commitment to continue to further develop in their faith and knowledge of Jesus Christ. They also receive the word of God, to remind them that Scripture and Tradition are the source of our faith. Those enquirers who are already baptised are also acknowledged and welcomed into our community during this celebration.
