### A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke

Be merciful as your Father is merciful.

Jesus said to his disciples: 'I say this to you who are listening: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who treat you badly. To the man who slaps you on one cheek, present the other cheek too; to the man who takes your cloak from you, do not refuse your tunic. Give to everyone who asks you, and do not ask for your property back from the man who robs you. Treat others as you would like them to treat you. If you love those who love you, what thanks can you expect? Even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what thanks can you expect? For even sinners do that much. And if you lend to those from whom you hope to receive, what thanks can you expect? Even sinners lend to sinners to get back the same amount. Instead, love your enemies and do good, and lend without any hope of return. You will have a great reward and you will be sons of the Most High, for he himself is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked.

'Be compassionate as your Father is compassionate. Do not judge, and you will not be judged yourselves; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned yourselves; grant pardon, and you will be pardoned. ### Becoming Catholic - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

(RCIA) is the process whereby adults enter the Catholic Church. RCIA classes are held weekly and over the course of several months those who attend the RCIA classes are educated on what the Catholic Church teaches and members in the program are given the opportunity to ask questions about those teachings.

The RCIA is a communal process and involves a number of stages punctuated by liturgical rites to aid and assist the potential convert toward the final rite, usually at the Easter Vigil at which time they will become full members of the Roman Catholic Church.

The Parish RCIA program at St. Nicholas of Myra Parish will begin with an information night (Monday 25th February 7.30pm In PMR 1) and continues through the Easter season. This program is open to any adult who (1) interested in becoming Catholic, (2) in need of receiving any one or all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion, (3) wishes to enter into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church, or (4) has been away from the Church and wants to return and/or just wants to learn more about the teachings of the Church.
