Becoming a Catholic - Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process whereby adults enter the Catholic Church. RCIA classes are held weekly and over the course of several months. Those who attend the RCIA classes are educated on what the Catholic Church teaches. Members in the program are given the opportunity to ask questions about those teachings.

Significant Initiation of Action of

The RCIA is a communal process and involves a number of stages punctuated by liturgical rites to aid and assist the potential convert toward the final rite, usually at the Easter Vigil at which time they will become full members of the Roman Catholic Church.

This program is open to any adult who 1) is interested in becoming a Catholic, 2) is in need of receiving any one or all of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion, 3) wishes to enter into full communion with the Roman Catholic Church, or 4) has been away from the Church and wants to return and/or just wants to learn more about the teachings of the Church.

Parish Priest Corner

Dear friends in Christ.

Our parish is a very multicultural community and for many of us this is like their own home. They support our parish with their time, talent and stewardship. I am so humbled with your commitment and generosity. Many of you who are supporting the parish through planned giving have already collected their new envelopes. There are still few more left to be collected. We have more than 1500 faithful come over to our Church on weekends to partake in the Eucharistic celebration. We are trying to make our community more vibrant and welcoming. The parish continues to serve everyone and show God's love and mercy and this is possible only with everyone's support. Perhaps some of you may not be aware of why we need a strong stewardship. The parish has many weekly/fortnightly expenses to cover. Some expenses are small, while others are big. For example; many of you are aware that our Church has been leaking during the heavy rain and it is due to the aging of the roof. The roof of the church has been 55 years old and most of its parts rusted. Experts advised us to replace the whole roof to treat the leaking. As a result, the financial council together with Fr. Matthew, the former Parish priest decided to replace the roof in 5 stages in which two are completed now. Each stage cost us more than \$45000.00. The cost of running and maintaining our parish building and community is steadily increasing year by year. However, our stewardship collection continues to decrease every week. I know it is a hard time for many and the only way we can improve our situations is trying to save here and there a little bit and that will make a difference in our stewardship. Let us pray together and see how we can we improve our stewardship. I depend on your continued support and if you have any suggestions please let me know. The words of St. Paul to his Corinthian Christians as they faced similar situation is important to remember. He said that each one must give as he/she has decided in his/her heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. (2 Corinthians 6-7).
