



#### Mary MacKillop: The First Australian Saint

Mary Helen MacKillop was born on 15 August 1842 in Fitzroy, Melbourne, to parents of Scottish origin. When the MacKillop family fell into difficult times, Mary, the eldest of eight children helped support the family. She took a job as a governess. It was there, teaching the children of the house and others, that she realised her vocation for teaching. This position brought Mary into contact with the local parish priest **Rev. Father Julian Tenison-Woods** who saw great potential in Mary to help remedy the lack of education (especially Catholic education) in Australia. Together with the

Rev. Father Julian Tenison-Woods, she founded the Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart. On 21 November 1866, the feast day of the Presentation of Mary, several other women joined Mary MacKillop. She adopted the religious name of **Sister Mary of the Cross, RSJ** and began wearing a simple religious brown habit, colloquially known as 'Brown Joeys.' It was the first religious institute to be founded by an Australian.

The "Rule of Life" (rules for community living) developed by Rev. Father Tenison- Woods and Mary MacKillop emphasized poverty, a dependence on divine providence, no ownership of personal belongings, faith that God would provide, and willingness to go where needed, was approved by Bishop of Adelaide, Laurence Bonaventure Sheil, OFM. Sadly, Bishop Sheil, due to poor health and absences at the First Vatican Council, and less time in his episcopate resulted in lack of clear guidance within the clergy, compelling Bishop Sheil, on advice received about the Josephites, to excommunicate Sr. Mary of the Cross, (Mary MacKillop) in Sept. 1871 citing insubordination as the reason. The Josephites were not disbanded but free to remain under the diocese if they chose. Throughout 1872 Sheil's health steadily deteriorated. On his deathbed in Willunga, he rescinded his excommunication of Sr. Mary of the Cross, claiming he had been betrayed by his advisors.

In 1873 Mary journeyed to Rome to seek Papal approval of the Josephite order. In 1888, Pope Leo XIII gave the final approval with some changes, to the Order of the Sisters of St. Joseph of the Sacred Heart.

Meanwhile Sr. Mary of the Cross's health deteriorated, suffering various medical problems, including a stroke in 1902 causing paralysis to her right side. Valiantly she carried on serving her community. Sr. Mary of the Cross died at the Josephite convent in North Sydney on 8, August 1909, The Archbishop of Sydney, Cardinal Moran said, "I consider this day to have assisted at the deathbed of a saint".

Devotions to Sr. Mary of the Cross arose almost immediately after her death. Her body was moved to a memorial chapel and the process of canonization began in 1925. There was some delay in the canonization process, but after multiple women were cured of cancer due to Sr. Mary's intercession, she was finally canonized in October 2010 by Pope Benedict XVI as Saint Mary MacKillop. Australia regards Saint Mary MacKillop with reverence and considers her to be an inspirational figure in the history of the country. Saint Mary MacKillop's feast is celebrated on August 8. **On Thursday 8th August there will be TWO Masses : at 9.30 am and 7 pm**
