How To Use Rosary Beads

- 1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the 'Apostles Creed'
- 2. Pray the 'Our Father'
- 3. Pray three 'Hail Marys'
- 4. Pray the 'Glory Be to the Father' prayer

5. Announce the first Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful or Glorious Mystery depending upon what mysteries you are meditating on this particular day, then pray the 'Our Father'

- 6. Pray ten 'Hail Marys'
- 7. Pray 'Glory Be to the Father'.
- 8. After each decade pray the 'Fatima Prayer'

9. Announce the Second Mystery, then pray 'Our Father'. Repeat 6,7,8 and continue with the Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.

10. Pray the 'Hail Holy Queen' after the five decades are completed and conclude with the 'Sign of the Cross'.

During the Month of October we will be praying the Rosary every day 15 minutes before Mass. You are most welcome to join in.




