A Festive Mass celebrating our Patron Saint—St Nicholas of Myra will be taking place on Sunday 8 December at 10am with a morning tea to follow.


## St Nicholas, Bishop | 06 December

Died in the fourth century. Bishop of Myra (Turkey) but nothing more is known about his life. Since the tenth century, widely venerated and frequently claimed as a



patron in both East and West. His cult in the West was further ensured when his relics were moved from Myra to Bari (Italy) in the eleventh century. Remembered because his reputation for generosity led to the custom of giving children gifts on his feast day, and thus to the Christmas figure of Santa Claus.


