#### **ARRANGEMENTS FOR MASS ATTENDANCE**

Booking arrangements: If you wish to attend Mass in the next few weeks; you will need to call the Parish Office to book in. You are able to book one Weekend Mass per month to allow others the chance to attend. Bookings for Daily Mass are dependant on numbers. We will not be taking bookings via email or via voicemail—it is imperative that you speak with the Parish Office to confirm your booking.

**Weekend Mass times:** There are three (3) public Masses available; Saturday Vigil at 6pm; Sunday at 8.30am; Sunday at 10am

**Livestream and Dispensation:** Mass will continue to be live streamed at the normal times (see image above). All continue to be dispensed from their Sunday obligation—please use the Spiritual Communion.

### **Booked Mass protocols (Covid-19 Restrictions)**

If you start to feel unwell, please do not attend Mass. As you enter the church (via the carpark entrance);

- Please follow the directions of the volunteer
- Only those who have booked in may attend Mass
- Please sanitise hands as you enter and leave
- Social distancing seating is in place. The pews will be sanitised after each Mass, therefore, you must sit in the allocated areas marked by the signage.
- The Maximum of 10 worshippers do not include, the priest and any helpers (sacristan, choir, readers, acolytes etc).

- During Mass; there will be no physical exchange of peace and Holy communion will be given in the hand.
   There will be no need to line up as the priest will approach each person at the aisle of the pews.
- There is no formal collection but there will be a basket at the door as you leave—we appreciate your generosity at this time.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available by appointment only. We are unable to use the Confessionals at this time, so we have set up a room in the parish office to celebrate this sacrament. This will usually take place during office hours unless another time has been arranged.

Personal time with the Lord Church will be open for personal prayer and visiting the Blessed Sacrament every day from Monday to Friday from 10 am to 1.30 pm. You will be required to leave your contact details on a name register at the at the entrance. Please exercise personal hygiene, social distancing and common courtesy when visiting to help ensure that only 10 people are in the church at one time.


