ARRANGEMENTS FOR MASS ATTENDANCE

From 1st June onwards the church has been opened for public Masses for up to 50 people. Please be mindful that we are returning to our Worship place during a time where Covid-19 is still a threat. As we adjust to this, we should all be extra prudent and prepared in observing all necessary precautions to avoid contracting the virus whilst gathering in larger numbers. Therefore we wish to advise the following guidelines are in place at St. Nicholas of Myra Catholic Church Penrith.

- Please sanitize your hands as soon as you enter the church
- At the doors of the church there are sign on sheets for you to leave your details—these will be kept confidential—but are necessary in case anyone contract the virus.
- You are encouraged to wear a face mask.
- The aisles and pews are marked to facilitate the observance of social distancing practices. Seating is in place at the allocated numbers.
- Seating will be on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS. NOT ALL PEWS OF THE CHURCH WILL BE OPEN FOR SEATING.
- As you enter the church please occupy the middle seat of the pews at first, so that others can sit on the aisle starting from front pews.
- Please refrain from singing throughout the liturgy.
- As you prepare to exit the church please exit starting with the rows that are closest to the entrances.
- There will neither be a solemn entrance procession nor a recessional by the celebrant and ministers.

- No altar servers will be needed and there will be no procession of gifts, gifts will be kept at the altar area.
- The lectors and commentator will be seated at their designated seats prior to the Mass.
- The collection baskets are kept at the entrances of the Church rather than passed during the Mass.
- The sign of peace will be shared without physical contact.
- Only one acolyte is needed at each mass. We encourage
 you to volunteer and serve as needed, only priest and
 acolyte will be serving Holy Eucharist, after sanitizing the
 hands before and after the distribution of the Eucharist.
- If you are rostered on as a Eucharistic Minister in June and wish to volunteer at the doors please contact the office.
- During the communion, the social distancing will be followed and therefore communion will be brought to your seat. Communion should be received only in the hand.
- The obligation to participate in Sunday Mass is still lifted.
- Our utmost concern is the health and well being of our parishioners. Therefore, those who are feeling ill, or who have symptoms of fever, dry cough or sore throat should not come out to Mass but watch our Live stream at 10 am on Sundays (from Sunday June 7)

Diocese of Parramatta response to the ABC - 17 June 2020

The headlines read "Church in Parramatta asks priests to donate JobKeeper money to the Diocese".

This statement is untrue to the extent that no JobKeeper money was diverted to the Diocesan funds.

To clarify the position of the Diocese of Parramatta on this issue and to provide context, it is wellknown that religious organisations are entitled to make use of the JobKeeper program.

This is public information and is not something new.

As parishes were forced to shut down for months due to COVID-19, collection plate donations which go towards the clergy stipend came to an abrupt halt. In some instances, this meant a 100% drop in donations to some parishes.

Some members of the clergy were eligible for JobKeeper. They may or may not choose to avail themselves of the program. The money they received was used to help offset the loss of those donations.

Given the extremely rapid nature and changing legislation around COVID-19, the Diocese of Parramatta sought independent advice on this issue to ensure we were adhering to the requirements.

Based on this independent advice, and to ensure we kept within the spirit and intention of JobKeeper, it was decided the best use of the funds was to direct clergy to keep the payment.

Clergy were free to make a voluntary contribution to the clergy support fund, if they chose to do so.

The Diocese of Parramatta is grateful to the Federal Government for this assistance.

We are mindful of the many in the community who are doing it tough during this crisis.

We are confident that our clergy-recipients of JobKeeper will put the taxpayer-funded money to good use.
