New COVID-19 restrictions

As announced by the NSW Premier further restrictions are in place. As a result, Masses and funerals will be limited to 100 people. The one person per four square metre rule still applies. Therefore, we wish to advise the following guidelines that are in place at St Nicholas of Myra Catholic Church:

- ♦ The number of people inside the church are limited to 100, which excludes door volunteers and those who are assisting for the celebration of the Mass, such as acolyte, lector, commentator and choir maximum 3 people in 3 metre distance. Everyone is encouraged to wear face mask.
- There are two extra Masses in the Parish Hall with maximum of 50 parishioners per Mass: Saturday 6 pm and Sunday 10 am.
- The aisles and pews are marked to facilitate the observance of social distancing practices. Seating is marked with a number on the pews and please sit only in those areas that are marked.
- ♦ At the doors of the church there are sign on sheets for you to leave your details, name, contact details etc- these will be kept confidential- but are necessary in case anyone contracts the virus.
- Please sanitize your hands as soon as you enter the church.
- Please occupy the central seat of pews first, starting from the front pews of the church, so that others who come after you will be able to occupy the aisles while observing social distancing.
- Please continue to refrain from singing throughout liturgy.
- There will neither be a solemn entrance procession nor a recessional by the celebrant and ministers.
- No altar servers will be needed and there will be no procession of gifts, gifts will be kept at the credence table near the altar.
- The sign of peace will be exchanged without physical contact.
- During the communion, the social distancing will be observed and therefore communion will be brought to your seat. Communion should be received only in the hand.
- Only one acolyte/ senior server and one Extra-ordinary minister of communion would be required other than priests/ deacon to serve during the Mass.
- The collection baskets are kept at the entrances of the church and hall rather than passed during the Mass.
- As you prepare to exit the church please exit starting with the rows that are closest to the entrances.
- The obligation to participate in Sunday Mass is still lifted.

It is important for everyone to maintain physical distancing and follow all health and safety guidelines. Our utmost concern is the health and well being of our parishioners. Therefore, those who are feeling ill, or who have symptoms of fever, cold, dry cough or sore throat should not come out to attend Mass but watch our live stream Mass at 10am on Sundays.

Dear Parishioners

It has been six months since all of us have made changes to how we worship. We thank you for the willingness and speed with we

have seen you embrace these changes, some of them difficult and possibly confusing. The positive response by the Catholic Community of Western Sydney and the Blue Mountains was recently reinforced by NSW Health who are working with us through our Diocese to make sure what we do at church keeps us safe.

Your efforts are noticed and appreciated.

We have witnessed how easily the virus can spread at churches, and we support the government's regulations and recommendations. Our Parish is a registered COVID-safe organization, and in order to remain so, we need to follow certain practices.

By now you will be used to parts of our plan such as setting maximum attendance, recording Mass attendees' contact details, sanitizing our hands, and sitting in the marked pews. Even the chat after Mass with our friends has sadly had to go for now

We are also pleased to see so many of you wearing masks. This is a practical way you can show you care for the health of others, and we would like to see our entire parish to take up mask wearing whenever you come to church.

We have recently been advised by NSW Health that singing in groups has been found be high risk. As such the Diocese is highly recommending we find other ways of including music in our Mass besides live music and congregational singing or choirs. Any singers must be 5 metres away from others.

Thank you for following the advice issued so far. I'm sure you will have heard this pandemic referred to as a marathon rather than a sprint. The bottom line is our concern for everyone's safety, and your compliance means you are all playing an important role in keeping the community safe.
