PARISH PRIEST MESSAGE

Dear friends in Christ,

On 24th of May, this coming Tuesday, we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lady, Help of Christians. Our country Australia is dedicated to the Maternal care of Mary Help of Christians, and she is the patroness of our nation. Our parish community is specially

blessed to have a grotto/ shrine in honour of Mary help of Christians.

Many times, in history the faithful gathered before the statue of the Mary Help of Christians for intercession on their behalf, especially in time of danger and war. Last few years we have been fighting to survive the Covid-19 Pandemic. We have seen and experienced hardships and difficulties due to this virus. Many lives were lost and continue to be lost. We will implore her to intercede to her Son for World Peace, especially for Ukraine and Russia, through praying the Rosary. We will dedicate our families, our parish, and our nation to her

> maternal care for safety and protection. We also come as a parish community to seek her help to face various challenges of life and to embrace more and more God's will for us. We are in winter, and therefore it would be cold, but I think this is an opportunity for us to experience and understand the cry of the people, especially the refugees, who have lost their home and country due to war in Ukraine. In solidarity with these people, we too can gather in the grotto, even though it is cold. So, I

hope many of us can make small sacrifices and offer our sufferings to our Lord in our Eucharistic Celebration outdoors on that day.

May you be all richly blessed for the goodness of your heart.

RCIA: NEXT WEEK GOSPEL REFLECTION

The Gospel - The Ascension of The Lord Luke 24: 46-53. The Ascension of the Lord celebrates two aspects of the resurrection, namely *Jesus' exaltation* and the *commissioning of his followers to carry on his mission*.

The Christian community has a duty to evangelise:

To convey the life image revealed in the Gospel and in our Christian tradition. This is not just the responsibility of the clergy or of religious men and women, but is the duty of every Christian, and evolves from the character of being a disciple.

The Christian community does not act alone:

Jesus promised "I will be with you always, to the very end of time" Matthew 28:20. He is 'God-with-us'. Through his Spirit, Jesus continues to work with and through his people, and he is to be found in every one of us. In every person we meet, we either come face to face with the presence of Jesus, because of that person's goodness, love, generosity, compassion, courage, and concern for others: OR meet someone who needs the healing touch of Jesus because of their brokenness. In response to Jesus' call, we must be, generous, compassionate, non-judgemental, caring and loving as we live out our daily lives. "As often as you did (or did not do) it to one of the least of my brothers, you did (or did not do) it to ME." Matthew 25:35-46.

- Where in your life do you find genuine 'selfemptying' love?
- ♦ Pray for the grace to offer such love to others.
- ♦ How do you fulfil the commission, given by Jesus at the time of his Ascension, to proclaim the Gospel.
