PARISH PRIEST MESSAGE

Planned Giving Envelopes:

Dear friends in Christ.

Some of you have approached me about how the parish is doing regarding our finance. As you know our main source of income is via the Planned Giving Program. The 2022/2023 Planned Giving envelopes period will commence on the weekend of 2/3 August. We thank all those who give so generously through the envelopes and we also thank the many parishioners who have taken up the option to give to the St. Nicholas of Myra, Parish Planned Giving via Credit/Debit Card payments or Direct Debit/ Credit.

Over the last 2 ½ years we have had a number of Planned Giving envelops issued with many of them not being collected. A few of you shifted to direct debit/ direct credit to support which is also very good for the Stewardship of the parish and no longer use the Planned Giving Envelopes.

Every year we buy the Planned Giving Envelopes which is an expense to the Parish. If you have not collected your envelopes for this year but you wish to remain on the Planned Giving envelope system, please phone, or email the Parish office.

If we have not had any contact from you by the end of June no further envelopes will be issued and you will be removed from the Parish Planned Giving.

If you would like to alter your way of giving or join the Parish Planned Giving, please phone the Parish office to make arrangements.

Please continue to support your parish community through stewardship as this is the only way the parish can meet its expenses. You can see below how Covid affected our Planned Giving and other collections.

RCIA: NEXT WEEK GOSPEL REFLECTION

The Gospel - PENTECOST Sunday

John 14:15-16.23-26. (Mass of the Day Year C) Pentecost is a major feast in the Church and is considered by many as the birthday of the Church and celebrates the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on all of us. The Holy Spirit is the empowering and creative gift of God that shapes the inner life of the Catholic community. It is the catalyst for the community to reach outward in mission, and so forms a church that is inclusive and far-reaching. There are two qualities that always accompany the presence of Jesus in our lives - PEACE and LOVE, and from peace and love come KINDNESS and TRUTH, and kindness and truth meet in love. The Holy Spirit leads us to love and hope, and do not have a dark side, as both begin with forgiveness. The Spirit is also the source of the special gifts (or charisms') which each baptised member of the community receives. There are many different gifts, but they are not given as personal grace for oneself. They are a special ability or talent intended for use in service to the community. We are meant to work together, using our gifts, to build up the community to which we belong. The Spirit has come to us, perhaps not through a mighty wind or the breath of the risen Lord, but through the waters of baptism and the oils of anointing. Let us be thankful and rejoice in receiving the gifts Spirit, the third person of the Trinity.

OUR GOSPEL REFLECTION AND QUESTIONS:

With the sight of Jesus, fear turned into great joy. Anxiety turned into relief. Desperation turned into vindication. Most importantly, a lack of spiritual direction turned into a sense of deep spiritual grounding. **How does this make you feel?**
