PARISH PRIEST MESSAGE

St. Nicholas of Myra: A Parishioner's reflection on the 10 am Pentecost celebration

The words of Pope Francis "only the Holy Spirit is able to kindle diversity, multiplicity and at the same time bring about unity'

certainly rang true in the Penrith Parish of St. Nicholas of Myra on Pentecost Sunday morning.

An air of expectancy, aa blaze of light and colour, warm hospitality, good fellowship, and a joyous spirit were at the heart of his multicultural celebration of Mass.

On entering the Church one was taken aback by the outburst of light and colour which permeated the entire surroundings. The symbols of Pentecost- the Holy Spirit, flames, wind, the breath of God and a dove were all depicted in the beautiful banners adorning the walls.

Images of doves descending or in flight, tongues of fire, leaping flames, beautiful floral arrangements, national costumes, and the vibrant colour of red worn by choir and many parishioners symbolising the joy and fire of the Holy Spirit were all to the fore on this great day of Celebration.

As the choir sang, the clergy, resplendent in their red vestments, processed down the aisle, preceded by flag- bearers carrying flags from countries such as Hungary, Vatican City, the Philippines, Britain, and Australia.

In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostle we were reminded- "they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different languages"- and so it was in our prayers of the faithful when the languages of French, Tagalong, Maltese, Samoan, Sri Lankan, Spanish, Indian and English rang out loudly and clearly- and were again heard mingling with the Australian

voices in the Lord's Prayer.

On this special day 5 new families were welcomed into the Parish with gifts and resounding ovations.

As we all gathered for morning tea- our first major get together since Covid-19 and its restrictions had raised its ugly head and shrouded our lives- there were signs of joy, delight, and good cheer.


Indeed "a new wind was set loose upon the earth with a fresh breath of hope and empowerment.
