

A few of you shifted to direct debit/ direct credit to support which is also very good for the Stewardship of the parish and no longer use the Planned Giving Envelopes.

Every year we buy the Planned Giving Envelopes which is an expense to the Parish. If you have not collected your envelopes for this year but you wish to remain on the Planned Giving envelope system, please phone, or email the Parish office.

If we have not had any contact from you by the end of June no further envelopes will be issued and you will be removed from the Parish Planned Giving.
