PARISH PRIEST MESSAGE

Dear friends in Christ.

Greetings of Peace and Joy!

Last week, more than 20 choir group leaders and representatives had a meeting which started with prayer and reflection. During our reflection we shared the differences between 'choir and "church choir'. There were quite a few thoughts, but the most outstanding difference that stood out in our sharing was that 'the

choir' normally exists for music and performances. But the "church choir" exists to lead people through religious celebrations, and to help people praise and adore God'.

As a faith community we gather every Sunday around the altar of the Lord to offer our lives, its pains, and sorrows. We participate in Jesus' Life, Passion, Death, and Resurrection through the celebration of the Eucharist. We can't do this meaningfully without actively participating.

The "church choir" help us to enter fully into this celebration. They take hours and hours to prepare and practice the hymns, so that they can lead the congregation to praise and adore God in the Eucharist. But most times we do not take part in singing hymns or

Pope Francis at the Third International Meeting of Choirs said that the duty of the "church choir" is to "help community sing, not to replace its voice'.

During our meeting we discussed what can be done to encourage our community to participate in singing hymns and prayers.

The few important thoughts from the meeting are as follows:

- The choir group will often remind parishioners to sing with them.
- 2. They will endeavour to sing and introduce new and old hymns before the Mass to the community so that all become familiar with the hymns and so will sing and participate during the Mass
 - The community is also encouraged to actively participate by singing in the parts of the Mass that they are already familiar such as -Glory to God in the Highest, Holy, Holy, Lamb of

I think everyone needs to join in praising and adoring God. Pope Francis at the International Meeting of Choirs said, "Music can help make the Gospel efficacious in today's world, through a beauty that still captivates and makes it possible to believe, entrusting ourselves to the love of the

Father."


