

PARISH PRIEST MESSAGE

First, to all of you fathers: Happy Father's Day!

I trust you know what an honour and privilege it is to be a father. Fatherhood is a tremendous gift which comes along with an awesome responsibility. Being a 'Father' in the modern world is a great gift but also a challenge and I am sure that you will all agree that there is a distinct difference between a mother's love and a father's love for their children. Father's Day can recall many wonderful memories and feelings. I lost my father who suffered a stroke 5 years ago. I was fortunate enough to fly to India and visit my father in hospital. The next day he entered eternal life. During our Indian pilgrimages some of you saw him when you all visited my home in Kerala. He was a man of few words. Today as I think of him, I miss him dearly. He worked so hard, but, he also had his imperfections.

However, he was a man of faith. He shared his faith with us and helped us to experience God's presence and His love. He was truthful and honest. I have fond memories of my dad who used to join us in our family rosary in the evenings. When I think of my dad now, I feel that the greatest gift he has given me is the gift of faith. What greater gift can you receive from a father?

Today's Gospel speaks about the importance of wisdom in life. Nothing could better express the pride and emotion that a father feels when he understands that he has handed down to his child what really matters in life, that is, a wise heart. Any father will be so happy and proud when he sees his child speak and judge with wisdom and rectitude.

Pope Francis encouraged all fathers to be the guardians of their children as they grow in age, wisdom, and grace as St. Joseph was to Jesus. According to Pope Francis, fathers should guard their children on their journey, to be educators and walk with them.

Ideally, a father's love reflects God's love – a love that is gracefilled, merciful, forgiving, patient, kind and, most importantly, unconditional.

"Respect your father and your mother, so that you may live a long time in the land that I am giving you". (Exodus 20:12)
