#### PARISH PRIEST'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends in Christ,

We begin this year's Holy week with Palm Sunday or "Passion Sunday, which unites us all to the royal splendour of Christ with the proclamation of his Passion". The celebration of Eucharist begins with the blessing of Palms and the procession, commemorating Christ's entry into Jerusalem. I remember in growing up, our Palm Sunday celebrations began in a small shrine close to my home and we used to walk nearly half a kilometre through the main streets with the palms in our hands to our parish church singing and waving palms. I used to walk so proudly carrying and waving Palms through the streets to my Parish church. Palm Sunday Liturgy is very important in our faith life. In medieval times people used to believe that blessed palms will protect them from dangers. But, I think, more than keeping them as amulets, palms or olive branches are kept in the home as a witness to faith in Jesus Christ, the Messianic king, and in His pascal victory.

This coming week, as Christians we will participate in many events that are central to our faith. On Wednesday evening at 7 pm in our cathedral the bishop will bless the three Sacred Oils at a special liturgy known as the Chrism Mass. These Oils are then distributed to the parishes to use throughout the year. The Oil of Chrism is used during Baptisms, Confirmation, Ordination, and the Consecration of altars. The Oil of Catechumens is used at the Easter vigil. The Oil of sick is used to anoint people during the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

I invite you all to prepare ourselves for the Sacred Triduum. This coming Tuesday we have arranged for the Second Rite Reconciliation at 7 Pm. God's Mercy and compassion is calling us back to the confessional to reconcile ourselves which will help us to enter Holy week more profoundly. On Holy Thursday at 7 pm we will celebrate the Lord's supper. The Paschal Triduum of the Passion and Resurrection of the Lord begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, which is central in the Easter vigil. During Easter vigil Mass at 7pm, we will bless the Easter fire, the lighting of the Pascal Candle, the reading of salvation history, the celebration of the sacraments of initiation for catechumens and the acceptance of candidates to the full communion of the Catholic church. The renewal of baptismal promises for the faithful is once again an integral part of Holy Week celebrations. This year we have five catechumens for baptism and two candidates entering into the full communion of the Catholic Church. Let us continue to pray for Imelda, Tae Young, Jessica, Rikki Ellis, Riley Ellis, Charlton Ryan and Michelle Ellis as they continue their faith journey together with RCIA team.

I invite you to enter fully into the Sacred Triduum. The Great three Days of **Holy Thursday, Good Friday** and **Easter** call us to be transformed by love.

I wish you all a blessed Holy Week.


