October: Month of Rosary-Rosary Triduum and Holy Mass: Oct 25th -27th

Dear Parishioners.

As we embark on this sacred month of October, dedicated to the Rosary, let us embrace the profound power of this prayer that has provided solace and guidance to countless souls in their times of need. As Christians, we hold the belief that on Calvary, the Lord entrusted his beloved people to Mary, the spiritual Mother of all humanity.

I extend a heartfelt invitation, especially to families, to integrate the Rosary into your daily routine. You may come



30 minutes early before daily Mass to join us at the side of our Blessed Mother by praying the rosary with the parish community. We will culminate this devotion by coming together for a Rosary Triduum Mass at the Grotto of Mary Help of Christians on the 25th, 26th, and 27th of October at 7 pm. Please reserve these evenings in your diary to attend.

A triduum, spanning three days, is a period of focused prayer. During this time, our intentions will be fervently offered for the well-being of families. Recent studies in our nation have revealed an alarming rise in divorce rates, coupled with a decline in yearly marriages. While the challenges of the past year may have played a part, it is important to recognize the detrimental effects of divorce and parental separation on children, families, and society.



May Mother Mary's intercession be a guiding light for all our families.






