#### First, to all of you fathers: Happy Father's Day!

I trust you know what an honour and privilege it is to be a father. Fatherhood is a tremendous gift which comes along with an awesome responsibility. Being a 'Father' in the modern world is a great gift but also a challenge and I am sure that you will all agree that there is a distinct difference between a mother's love and a father's love for their children. Father's Day can recall many wonderful memories and feelings.

I have fond memories of my dad who would join us in our family rosary in the evenings. When I think of my dad now, I feel that the greatest gift he has given me is the gift of faith. What greater gift can you receive from a father?

Today's Gospel speaks about the importance of renouncing self and taking up the cross, losing our lives for the sake of love. Our dads are called to follow the path of Christ - the path of love! May the father's love continue to touch the lives of their children. Nothing could better express the pride and emotion that a father feels when he understands that he has handed down to his child what really matters in life, that is, a wise heart.
