PARISH PRIEST MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

"But the angel said to them, 'do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord. (Luke 2: 10-11)


