#### LENTEN SYMBOL



The symbolism of the mother pelican feeding her young with her own blood is called a "Pelican in her Piety". Christians see parallels between the mother pelican and Jesus and his followers. When food is in short supply the pelican pierces its breast with its sharp

pointed beak and the side of Jesus was pierced by a sharp pointed lance (Jn 19:34a). Blood flowed from the pelican's breast, blooded flowed from Jesus' side (Jn 19:34b). The mother's blood is drink for her chicks, and the blood of Jesus is "true drink" (Jn 6:55b). The mother gives her life that her chicks might live, and Jesus laid down his life that we might live (Jn 15:23). The body and blood of Jesus is salvation and eternal life for those who receive it. The mother pelican and her chicks have come to represent the Eucharist, as well as redemption and salvation.
