Dear Parishioners,

Greetings of Peace!

I would like to extend my heartfelt gratitude to all of you for your unwavering support over the past financial year. Your generosity has been instrumental in sustaining our parish's mission and activities.

In Australia, we have two collections every weekend:

- 1. **First Collection**, goes to the Board of Management to support the Priests of the Diocese.
- 2. **Second Collection and donations**, covers the expenses of our Parish Church, including rates, staff salaries, maintenance, and other necessary costs.

Our stewardship program is thoughtfully designed to accommodate anyone in our parish who wishes to contribute and support. We use different methods of stewardship for the second collection that can be used by anyone in our community.

- Planned Giving Envelopes: one of our oldest ways of giving and some
 prefer this mode, and the envelopes are available in the foyer from this
 week, for those who support us in this way. Please take your envelopes if
 you are one of them.
- **Direct Debit or Credit Card:** Many parishioners support us through direct debit or credit card. This is more preferred way because it has less logistics and safer..
- **Direct transfers, Tap & Go**: Another easy and safer method of Stewardship.
- **Loose change**: some visitors and others do support us with loose change during the collections.

We are deeply thankful for your support, regardless of the method you choose. Your contributions are vital for our ongoing mission.

Since COVID-19, our collections have dropped by 30%. However, with your continued support and collaboration, we are hopeful that we can bridge this gap in the coming months. If you haven't yet signed up for stewardship, please consider completing a **direct debit or credit card form**. This is very simple and easy. This method is convenient for both you and for our church. Please talk to a priest if you wish to support this way. The forms are available at the doors of the church.

I also want to acknowledge and express my gratitude to our Finance Council team, wardens and counters for their unwavering commitment and diligent work in managing our finances.

Once again, thank you for your stewardship. May the Lord bless us abundantly.


