

I trust you know what an honour and privilege it is to be a father. Fatherhood is a tremendous gift which comes with an awesome responsibility. Being a 'Father' in the modern world is a great gift but also a challenge. I am sure that you will all agree that there is a distinct difference between a mother's love and a father's love for their children.

**Father's Day** can bring to our minds many wonderful memories and feelings. I lost my father from a stroke 7 years ago, but I was fortunate enough to fly to India and visit him in hospital. The next day he entered eternal life. During our Indian Pilgrimages some of you saw him when you visited my home in Kerala. He was a man of few words. Every day I miss him dearly. He worked so hard, and he also had his imperfections.


