#### **PARISH PRIEST MESSAGE:**

This Sunday's readings offer us a deep spiritual reflection on how God provides for us both physically and spiritually and, how we are called to respond to His love.

In the First Reading, we see the prophet Elijah at a moment of great despair. He's exhausted, fearful, and ready to give up. But, in this moment of weakness, God doesn't abandon him. Instead, He sends an angel to provide Elijah with food—a simple meal of baked scones—that gives him the strength to continue his journey to the mountain of God. This isn't just a story of physical nourishment, but a powerful symbol of how God sustains us in our spiritual journey as well. When we are weary or discouraged, God meets us where we are, offering us what we need to keep moving forwards toward Him.

The Gospel Reading deepens this theme by revealing how God's provision reaches its fullness in Jesus. Jesus presents Himself as the "bread of life," the true and ultimate nourishment for our souls. This statement is rich with spiritual significance. Bread, in the Jewish tradition, often symbolizes God's word—the sustenance that feeds our souls. When Jesus says He is the bread of life, He's telling us that He is the source of all we need for spiritual life and growth.

The spiritual significance here is profound: just as our bodies need food to survive, our souls need the Word of God to thrive. The Word of God is our spiritual nourishment-it sustains us, guides us, and strengthens us on our journey through life.

Mary's mission was the same: to call us her children to her Son, to build an intimate relationship with her Son and to receive our daily strength from Him. This week, as we prepare to celebrate the Feast of the Assumption, we reflect on Mary, the Mother of Jesus and the Mother of God, who continually calls us to her Son and invites us to build our lives with Him. Throughout her different apparitions around the world, Mary has guided us toward a deeper relationship with Christ, remaining also as our loving Mother who intercedes for us.

The Feast of the Assumption, which we will celebrate this Thursday, is a Holy Day of Obligation, a time for us to come together as a community to honour Mary's unique role in God's plan of salvation and to thank her for her maternal protection.

As part of our celebration, we will hold a 7:00 pm Mass on the 15th August, with a rite of blessing for the icons of Our Lady. I invite you to bring statues of Mary and the saints from your home to the church to be blessed during this Mass at 7.00 pm. This act is a renewal of our love for God and Mary, deepening our devotion and reaffirming our commitment to live under the guidance of our heavenly Mother.

Let us gather with hearts full of thanksgiving, asking Mary to lead us to her Son, Jesus, and to help us build our lives on His love.

On the 15<sup>th</sup> of August we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This is a Holy Day of obligation.


