PARISH PRIEST MESSAGE - ADVENT

A Time of Renewal and Joy: Embracing Advent and Our Patron's Feast



As we begin the first week of Advent, we are called to renew our lives in Christ and deepen our relationships with one another. This sacred season invites us to embrace humility, reflect on God's presence in our lives, and cherish each moment as a gift. Through love,

generosity, and kindness, we prepare our hearts to encounter the Lord more fully.

In this **Sunday's Gospel (Luke 21:25-28, 34-36)**, Jesus urges us to pay attention to the "**signs**" of God's Advent presence. He calls us to "**stand erect and raise our heads**," reminding us that God is near, even during life's challenges and uncertainties. This powerful message invites us to stay awake, remain hopeful, and recognize God's presence in our daily lives. Advent is not merely a time of waiting but a time of *awareness* and *preparation*, a time when we open our hearts to God's grace.

December is also a meaningful month for our St. Nicholas of Myra Parish. In addition to preparing for the birth of Jesus, we celebrate the feast of our patron, St. Nicholas of Myra, on Friday, December 6th. St. Nicholas embodied the spirit of Advent by recognizing God's presence in the needs of others and responding with generosity and love.

We will honour our patron during all Masses on the weekend of December 7th and 8th, praying for our families and asking for St. Nicholas' intercession. After each Mass, parishioners will receive a **blessed cake** to take home. Sharing this cake with family members is a **symbolic act** of love, care, and unity, reminding us of the importance of sharing our blessings and nurturing family bonds. Just as St. Nicholas brought joy through his generosity, we too are called to begin our acts of kindness within our homes.

Let this Advent be a time of renewed vigilance and joyful anticipation. By paying attention to God's presence in our lives and sharing His love with others, we prepare for the true joy of Christmas. May the example of St. Nicholas inspire us to live with hearts open to giving, sharing, and caring, especially for those closest to us.

Stay awake. Stand ready. Love generously.

This is the path to experiencing the fullness of God's joy this Advent season.
