Pentecost Multicultural Mass:

Weekday Eucharistic Adoration:

Starting on *Pentecost Monday*, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament each weekday from 9:00am until just before 9.30 am and 30 minutes before 12.10 Mass.

Divine Mercy Devotion:

From July onward, the Divine Mercy prayers will be held on the **First Friday** of each month, **after the Noon Mass**, instead of the Second Friday.

These will begin in the **second week of June**. Families wishing to receive a pastoral visit are invited to contact the parish office.

A new electronic candle stand has been installed in the foyer. We are deeply grateful to an anonymous donor who generously covered its cost.

Memorial Board:
