# Thanksgiving Mass for Milestone Birthdays & Wedding Anniversaries

This weekend at 10.00 am Mass, our parish family gathers in gratitude to celebrate among its parishioners, **36 milestone birthdays** and **23 special wedding anniversaries**. These occasions are not just personal milestones - they are moments of grace, reminders of God's goodness, and blessings to be shared with thanksgiving.


Recently a friend shared with me his sadness as, no matter what he had done for his family, he felt no one was grateful, and everything he did was taken for granted. We demand much but forget to say thank you. How true this is in many lives today! Gratitude is so often forgotten, and indifference has become one of the great sins of our modern world. Our former Pope Francis, warned us that "when we deceive ourselves into thinking that we do things on our own, we forget that all good comes from God."

The late Holy Father also often reminded us that gratitude opens our hearts to God and one another. He offered us three simple words as keys to peaceful, harmonious relationships: please, thank you, and I'm sorry. He encouraged us to ask ourselves: "Do I know how to say thanks? Do I know how to ask for forgiveness? Do I know how to say please without being invasive?" These questions remain a legacy of his wisdom.

In today's Gospel, the parable of the rich man and Lazarus challenges us to overcome indifference. The rich man failed to see the gift of Lazarus at his gate, and in the end, it was he who was truly impoverished. Indifference blinds, but gratitude gives sight.

So, today we give thanks to God for the gift of life, the gift of faith, and the gift of one another. Each birthday and every marriage anniversary is a testimony of God's grace at work in our community. A special thank you to all who submitted names for this celebration - your thoughtfulness allows us to pray together in gratitude.

May Mary, whose soul proclaimed the greatness of the Lord, help us to make gratitude the light that dawns daily in our hearts, so that we never take one another - or God's goodness - for granted. And may the words of Pope Francis continue to inspire us, to live as people who know how to say: *Please. Thank you. I'm sorry.*
